Chief complaint -

Patient complains of swelling in lower left buccal tooth region since 1 year.

Clinical Finding -

Soft palpable non tender gingival growth present at 33 & 34.

No pus discharge

Ulceration present.

Adjacent gingival inflammation present.

Size: 5 mm x 7 mm.

Microscopic finding -

The given H&E stain section reveals stratified squamous epithelium which is thin layered. Local areas show inflammation. In connective tissue stroma

there are thin walled blood vessels and capillaries which are arranged as lobules aggregated, separated by fibrous stroma. Moderate amount of inflammatory cells can also be seen.

Presumptive diagnosis - Pyogenic  
granuloma.

Final diagnosis - Pyogenic Granuloma.
