TOBACCO POUCH KERATOSIS

(CLINICAL PICTURE OF THE ANTERIOR LABIAL MUCOSA IN THE ANTERIOR VESTIBULAR REGION)

- PRESENCE OF GREYISH WHITE PATCH ON RIGHT LABIAL PART OF VESTIBULE EXTENDING FROM DISTAL ASPECT OF 42 TO MESIAL ASPECT OF 45.
- LESION WAS NON TENDER AND NON SCRAPABLE.
- FIRM AND GREYISH WHITE COLOUR
- HISTOLOGICAL FINDING - THE GIVEN H&E STAIN REVEALS EPITHELIUM COVERING CONNECTIVE TISSUE STROMA. IN THE SPINOUS CELL LAYER OF CONNECTIVE TISSUE REVEALED ACANTHOSIS WITH NUMEROUS INFLAMMATORY INFILTRATE CELLS. OVERALL FEATURES SUGGESTIVE OF KERATOSIS ASSOCIATED WITH TOBACCO

Oral Submucous Fibrosis

(clinical picture of diffused blanching whitish greyish patch in left vestibule region)

- DIFFUSED BLANCHING OF BUCCAL MUCOSA AND LEFT VESTIBULE SEEN THAT GIVES “MARBLE LIKE APPEARANCE “.
- REDUCED MOUTH OPENING AND BURNING SENSATION NOTICED .
- NON TENDER ON PALPATION.
- FIBROUS BAND ARE PALPABLE ON ANTERIOR VESTIBULE.

HISTOPATHOLOGY FINDING -

THE GIVEN H&E STAIN SECTION REVEALS, HYPERPLASTIC EPITHELIUM COVERING THE CONNECTIVE TISSUE STROMA. IN CONNECTIVE TISSUE STROMA, ABUNDANT AMOUNT OF COLLAGEN AND ATROPHY OF MUSCLES WERE ALONG WITH SUB-EPITHELIAL HYALINIZATION WHICH IS PROMINENTLY SEEN ,EPITHELIAL ATROPHY AND FLAT RETE RIDGES WITH SMALL AMOUNT OF DYSPLASTIC CELLS WERE SEEN .

- CHIEF COMPLAINT - PATIENT COMPLAINS OF ULCER AND PAIN IN THE LEFT CHEEK REGION SINCE 20 DAYS.
RADIOLOGICAL FINDING - NO RADIOLOGICAL FINDING NOTICED
- CLINICAL PICTURE AND FINDINGS :



LEUKOPLAKIA

(clinical picture of greyish white patch on the left buccal mucosa)

- PRESENCE OF GREYISH WHITE PATCH ON THE LEFT BUCCAL MUCOSA EXTENDING FROM DISTAL ASPECT OF 38 TO MESIAL ASPECT OF 35.
- LESION IS NON - SCRAPABLE AND SURFACE IS ROUGH.
- NO SIGN OF PUS DISCHARGE .
- ON PALPATION LESION FELT RAISED AND NON- TENDER
- SOME OF THE CLINICAL PICTURE APPEARED AS CRACKED MUD APPEARANCE

HISTOLOGICAL FINDINGS -

THE GIVEN H & E STAIN REVEALS HYPER KERATINIZED EPITHELIUM WITH BULBOUS RETEPEGS , COVERING THE CONNECTIVE TISSUE STROMA. MILD AMOUNT OF DYSPLASITIC FEATURES WERE SEEN IN EPITHELIUM ALONG WITH HYPERCHROMATIC NUCLEUS. CONNECTIVE TISSUE STROMA SHOWS MODERATE AMOUNT OF CHRONIC INFLAMMATORY CELLS. OVER ALL FEATURES SUGGESTIVE OF LEUKOPLAKIA .
